- WHEREAS: It was with deep regret that this City Council learned of the retirement of James F. Rice, Jr., City Engineer of Cambridge, effective January 8, 1982; and
- WHEREAS: James F. Rice was a graduate of Rindge Technical School prior to his enlistment in the United States Navy in July of 1941, where he served as an Assistant Mathematics Instructor prior to being transferred overseas for carrier duty in the Pacific; and subsequently attended the Naval Aeronautical Engineering School; and
- WHEREAS: James F. Rice entered the service of the City Engineering Department as a Civil Engineer Grade I on August 3, 1948 and rose through the ranks to Civil Engineer Grade IV, leading to his selection as Chief City Engineer on June 16, 1975; and
- WHEREAS: James F. Rice was a man of many talents and distinguished himself in the field of Structural Design and was the architect of many major engineering improvements in the City of Cambridge and qualified as a Registered Land Surveyor in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and left his mark on every civic improvement in the City of Cambridge; and when his signature was affixed to any plan or document, it merited the greatest measure of respect in any Court proceeding; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record expressing its gratitude to James F. Rice for a job well done as a City Official in the City of Cambridge, with the fervent hope that the coming years will be blessed with good luck, good fortune, good health and continuing achievement in his chosen field of endeavor; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mr. Rice on behalf of the entire City Council.

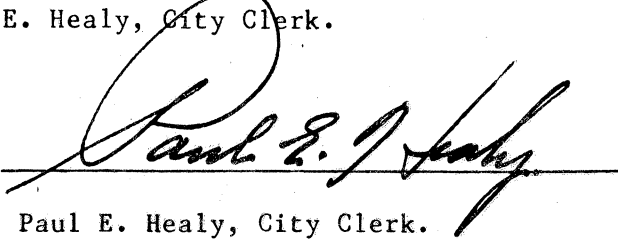
