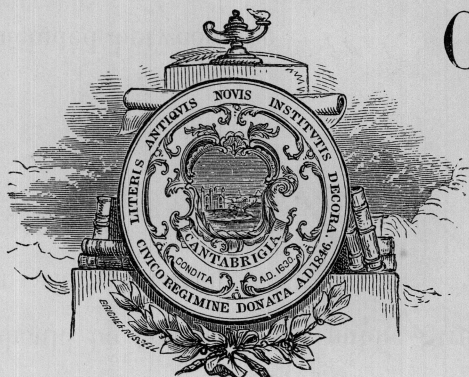




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Mellen Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *fifty feet* in width between

North Avenue
and Oxford Street,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

W. T. Barbour and A. Hodges
dated September 19, 1872,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and* that thirty days be allowed for the removal of fences or other obstructions standing on the land so taken as aforesaid.
