- WHEREAS: Father Metaxas first became the Pastor of Saints Constantine and Helen Church Cambridge in 1951, a position he has held ever since, until his transfer effective January 30, 1977 to Saint Athansius Church in Arlington, Mass., and
- WHEREAS: Father Metaxas has, over the years, always extended himself and his talents to the members of the Greek Community as well as to all the residents of Cambridge, who from time to time have come in contact with him, and
- WHEREAS: Father Metaxas has previously been active in civic as well as academic affairs in this city, backing Modern Language at Cambridge High and Latin School as well as teaching Greek at the Greek School of Saints Constantine and Helen, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere best wishes to the Reverend Arthur J. Metaxas on the occasion of his 26th Anniversary and to further extend to him our gratitude for all he has done for so many in our city, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Fr. Metaxas on behalf of this City Council.
