Memorandum of an agreement made and entered into this first of December, 1887, by and between the city of Cambridge, the party of the first part, and the other subscribers to this instrument, who are described together herein as the parties of the second part. -

Witnesseth :- that whereas the parties of the second part have furnished a certain plank sidewalk upon Brattle street in said city, which plank sidewalk for the term of five years from and after this date they desire shall be taken up and put down in the proper seasons, and stored when not in use, by the party of the first part, and for which service the parties of the second part offer and desire to pay the expense thereof, not to be less than the sum of one hundred dollars each year.

Now therefore the party of the first part hereby agrees that upon the payment to it of the said expense for one year not less than the sum of one hundred dollars, at the time of the execution of this agreement, and on the first day of each succeeding month of December, the expense as aforesaid for the following year, not to be less than one hundred dollars each year until five annual payments have been made, it will put down said plank sidewalk on or before the twentieth day of November in each year, and will take up the same on or before the twentieth day of May in each year, of the five years included within the provisions of this agreement. The party of the first part will also store the said plank sidewalk when not in use,
