WHEREAS: Marguerite F. Lechiaro has retired from the service of the Cambridge Public Library after forty years of employment, beginning on November 19, 1945; and

WHEREAS: During those 40 years she gave devoted service to the library as the first professional reference librarian on the library staff and as Head of Reference Services, built up a first class, professional Reference Department; and

WHEREAS: As Head of Public Services, she instituted a programming function for the library, including celebration of the ethnic communities of Cambridge and participation in the national Bicentennial and Cambridge 350th celebrations; and

WHEREAS: As Acting Director, guided the policies and activities of the library during the past three years; now, therefore, be it

ORDERED: That this Cambridge City Council pays tribute to and bestows honor upon Marguerite F. Lechiaro; and be it further

ORDERED: That the Cambridge City Council dedicate the Reference Room of the Main Library to Marguerite F. Lechiaro for Outstanding Leadership of the Cambridge Public Library, and that the Director of the Library make the necessary arrangements for the purchasing, placing in appropriate location, and dedication of a plaque, stating the above, at the Main Library of the Cambridge Public Library.
