WHEREAS:

James O'Callahan, a former employee of the Public Works Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Public Works Department on June 24, 1924 and was pensioned on November 5, 1948 under the provisions of Chapter 32 Section 57 of the General Laws and died on June 2, 1957 having served not less than twenty-four years, and

WHEREAS:

At the time of his death said employee had no right to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor, his widow, Elizabeth O'Callahan, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law, therefore be it

ORDER D:

That, under the provisions of Chapter 32 Section 101 of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by James O'Callahan an annuity be granted to Elizabeth O'Callahan, widow of James O'Callahan of \$1600.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.

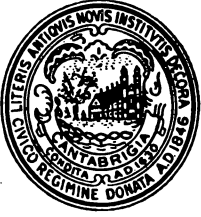
