May 19, 1980

- WHEREAS: In 1975 and 1976, an unprecedented democratic effort involved representatives of all Cambridge neighborhoods in a citywide comprehensive planning process which eventually culminated in eight element plan reports covering land use, housing, transportation, the universities, the economy, the environment, finance, and public services and facilities; and
- WHEREAS: These draft element plans have now been available for public discussion for four years; and
- WHEREAS: The City Council now wishes to proceed with a next phase of applying the principles of these plans to the city's neighborhood; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the Comprehensive Planning Advisory Group is revived and continued, including representation from all neighborhoods to be selected by neighborhood associations or planning teams, with instructions to update the eight element plan reports, to prepare suitable policy resolutions derived from their recommendations to the City Council for consideration and approval, and to monitor implementation of these plans and report to the City Council thereon; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the Advisory Group, in cooperation with the respective neighborhood associations and planning teams, formulate a detailed blueprint for implementing the principles of the citywide plans in each neighborhood; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager direct the Community Development Department to assign sufficient staff support for the above activities as it did in 1975-1976, and to report on progress to this City Council immediately after its 1980 summer recess.
