- WHEREAS: Sister Margaret Ann was assigned to North Cambridge Catholic as a teacher in 1967 and became Principal of the School in 1976 providing not only religious and spiritual guidance to the children of the school, but also leadership for the faculty and staff of the school; and
- WHEREAS: Sister Margaret Ann has always shown tremendous devotion to the youth of N.C.C.; now therefore be it

- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.

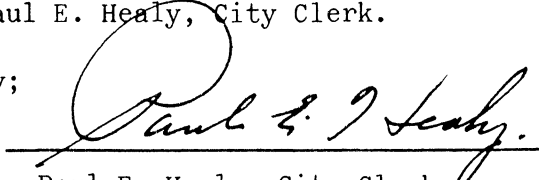
