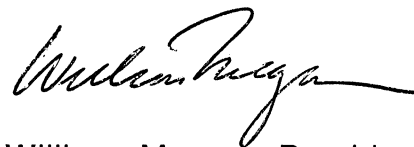
On behalf of our Youth Baseball programs, we would like to express our support for the extension of the City Manager's contract.

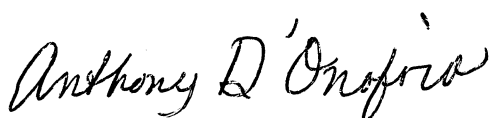
