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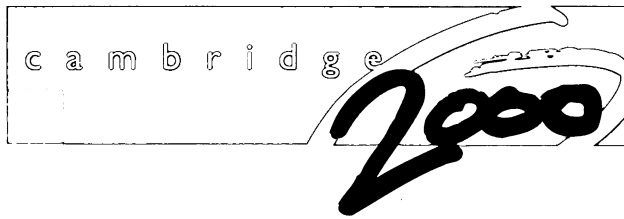

I am hereby requesting the appropriation from the U.S. Department of Justice to the Grant Fund Police Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$203,853.
