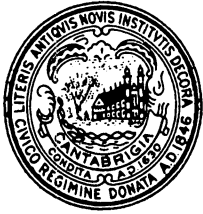

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I am pleased to inform the City Council that Cambridge has received a grant of \$25,000 from the National Endowment for the Arts, a Federal agency in Washington, D. C., "to support increased public awareness of the arts through the building of a coalition of arts resources, neighborhood groups and municipal governments". I respectfully request the City Council's approval of the acceptance of this grant and the further appropriation of these funds in the General Fund of the City of Cambridge. I have enclosed appropriate orders providing for same. This appropriation will supplement an earlier appropriation of \$5,000 passed by the City Council on September 29, 1975.


ARTS COUNCIL ESTABLISHED. As a result of this earlier appropriation, an "arts council" was established to fulfill three (3) of the four objectives stated in the grant applications. These objectives are:

- develop a specific mechanism for building public awareness of the possibilities for art and amenity in the city fabric.
- secure a staff capability to stimulate a broad partnership for implementation of arts and amenity projects amongst neighborhood organizations, civic groups, corporations, universities, and government agencies.
- utilize an advocate to specifically review city design plans, operating procedures of municipal agencies which control space and to critique existing city spaces in order to encourage workable amenity and art projects which serve both aesthetic and human needs.

The final objective stated in the grant application; implementing several small but highly visible projects, wall murals and street theatre; is currently being accomplished under the auspices of the City's C. E. T. A. program, approved by the City Council on May 5, 1975.

Passage of the attached orders is recommended.
