WHEREAS: Grozier Road residents are concerned with the safety of small children who reside there; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager converse with the Chief of Police regarding more traffic enforcement on Grozier Road during peak traffic hours when turning in from the Parkway is illegal; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Council be furnished with the results of the traffic study which was conducted by the Department of Traffic & Parking when Elmwood Avenue was closed to traffic entering from Fresh Pond Parkway so that we may determine whether the increase in the traffic on Grozier Road is due in any way to the blocking of Elmwood Avenue, and report back in two weeks time.
