COUNCILLOR DAVID SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Recent reports indicate a pattern of retaliation and harassment against tenants for asserting their legal rights, by Said Abu-Zahra, as trustee of the Six-S Realty Trust, the landlord of the rent controlled apartment buildings on Vail Court; and
- WHEREAS: Incidents of retaliation and harassment have, reportedly included tire slashings, illegal eviction by force, and targetting of tenant leaders for rent increases and attempted evictions; and
- WHEREAS: This pattern reportedly continues despite tenants' attempts to protect their rights at the Rent Control Board and in the courts; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager request the Chief of Police to conduct an immediate criminal investigation of this reported pattern of retaliation and harassment; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a copy of this resolution to the Trustee of Six-S Realty Trust; owner of the property in question, indicating that the City Council and the City Administration will not tolerate this kind of action; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Clerk transmit a copy of this order to the District Attorney, who is hereby requested to participate in this investigation and prosecute any crimes detected.
