IN CITY COUNCIL
February 25, 1980

- WHEREAS: George H. Friel, a former employee of the Fire Department of the City of Cambridge, entered the service of the Fire Department on July 27, 1918 and was pensioned on September 12, 1953 under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 81A, Sub-section A and Sections 81B and 94 of the General Laws and died on January 20, 1980, having served not less than thirty-five years; and
- WHEREAS: At the time of his death said employee had no rights to elect that benefits be paid to his survivor, said employee leaves as his survivor his widow, Mrs. Mary Friel, who has not remarried and is not receiving any retirement allowance or pension under the provisions of any general or special law; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That under the provisions of Chapter 32, Section 95A of the General Laws, Tercentenary Edition and amendments thereto, that in order to promote the public good and in consideration of the long and meritorious service performed by George H. Friel, an annuity be granted to Mrs. Mary Friel, widow of George H. Friel, of \$3,000.00 per year as long as she does not remarry.




