Notice is hereby given that the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering, acting in accordance with the provisions of M.G.L. Chapter 111, Section 142A through 142D, and in conformance with the Clean Air Act as amended August 7, 1977 will hold public hearings on the matter of the proposed revision of its regulations for the control of emissions from volatile organic compounds, identified as 310 CMR 7.00 and 7.18.

The source categories to be regulated in all Districts include, Surface Coating of Miscellaneous Metal Parts and Products; Graphic Arts; and Dry Cleaning Systems.

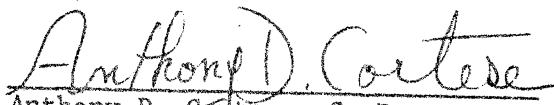
