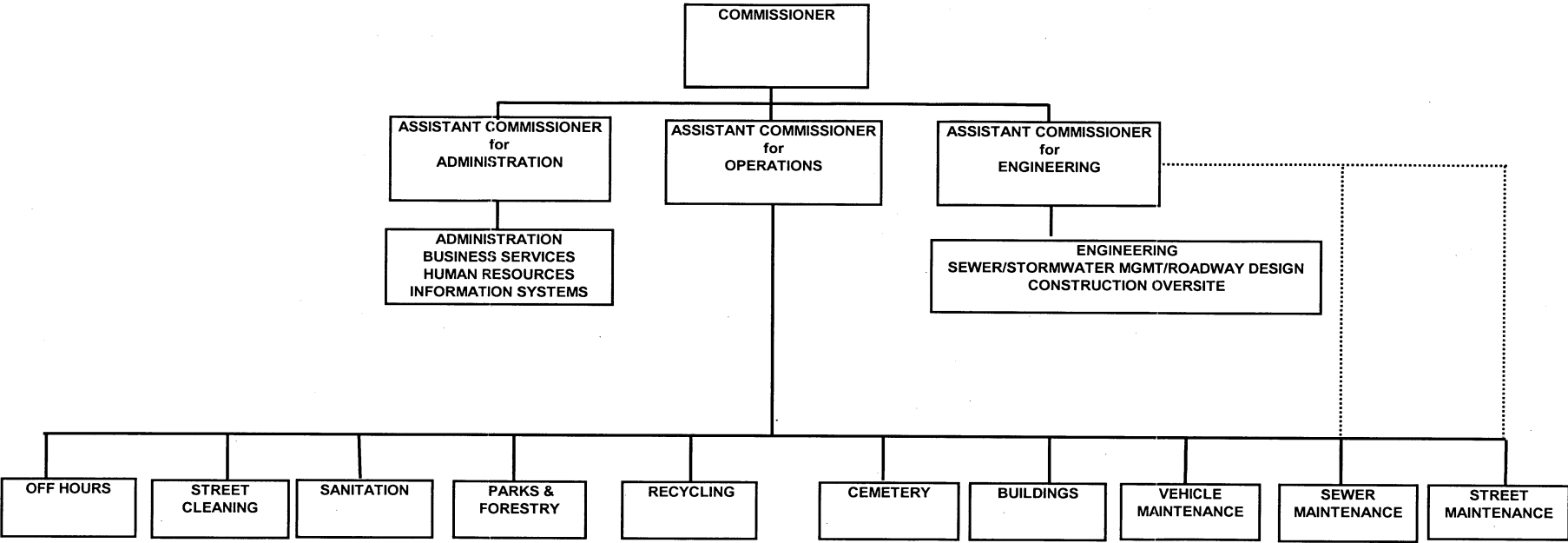

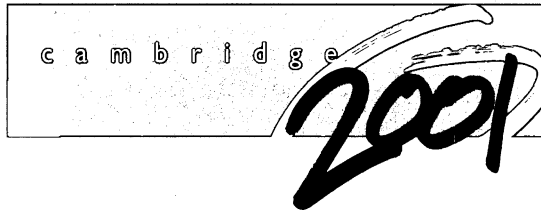
RE: Council Order regarding second visitor permit for seniors

This year we changed the past procedure of automatically issuing two visitor passes to all seniors whether they needed them or not. This change was made to reduce situations where a visitor pass was being used by a non resident who was commuting to the city for work, not visiting a resident. At the time this change was made, we also made a second visitor pass available to all the seniors who requested one by letter or note.

This change has had a beneficial overall impact on the integrity of the resident permit system. In order to enhance the ease of the program in 2002 for the seniors we will issue two visitor passes to every senior who had two this year. In this way the seniors needing two will not be inconvenienced. We would continue to honor new requests for two visitor passes.
