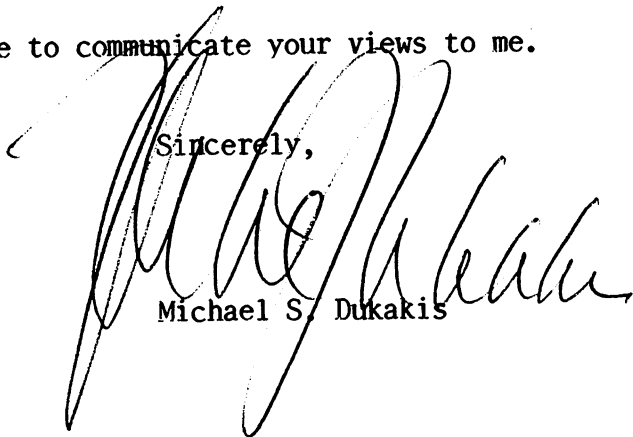
Dear Mr. Healy and City Councillors:
