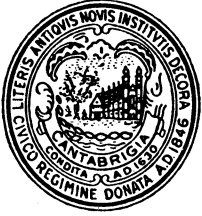

Dear Mr. Corcoran:

I have been requested by the Harrington-Wellington Citizens Committee and the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority to determine the possibility of constructing Municipal Parking Lots on two parcels of land now owned by the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority to assist the residents and businessmen in these areas.

The two parcels of land are at Cambridge Street and Warren Street as shown on Drawing No. PK-B-1078 and Cambridge Street and Windsor Street as shown on Drawing No. PK-C-1079. This land would be leased from the Cambridge Redevelopment Authority.

I have completed my study and have determined that these parking lots would help the residents and business people in these areas in that during the daylight hours, the lots would be used for customers and during the nighttime, these lots could be used by the residents.

Both these lots are designed for the use of parking meters and will blend in with the neighborhood as shown on the enclosed plans. These lots over a period of two years would pay for themselves, as this is the approximate time that the City could use these lots for parking. The cost of constructing these lots is approximately \$10,000.00 and the



potential income for this period would be \$9,000.00. These lots would also provide a needed service to the City of Cambridge.

I, therefore, request an appropriation in the sum of \$10,000.00 from the Parking Fund for the purpose of constructing these parking lots. It is important that if this appropriation is to be approved that it be done as soon as possible as the weather will be a factor in the construction.

I would be happy to discuss this with the City Council at their convenience.

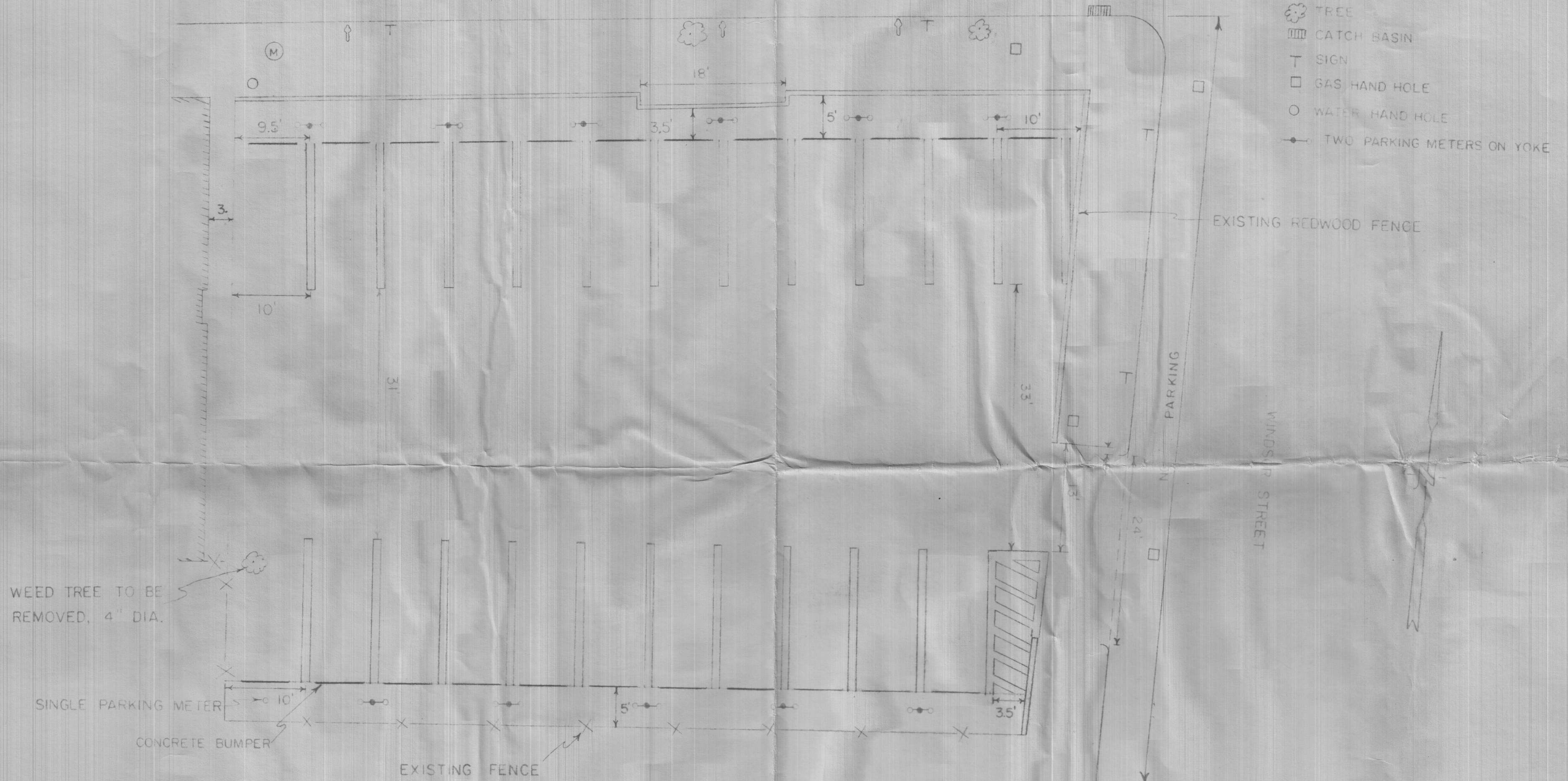

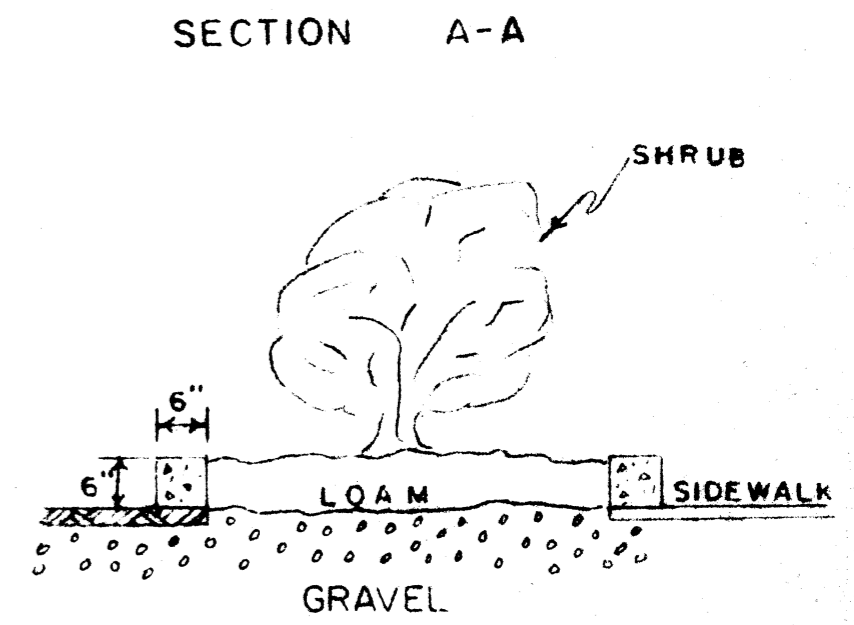
