John 'Jackie' Santini, celebrity hairstylist, 45

John "Jackie" Santini of Chelsea, hairstylist to well-known Bostonians, died Tuesday at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center after a lengthy battle with cancer. He was 45.

"He was just an incredible man," said friend, Mike Carucci, who knew Mr. Santini for 22 years.

Born in Boston, Mr. Santini was raised in South Boston and graduated from Boston Technical High School.

He owned and operated about 20 years John Santini's Studio for Hair on Newbury Street. The salon was frequented by prominent Boston politicians and entertainers, including former Red Sox pitcher Roger Clemens, rock singer Steven Tyler and the late U.S. Rep. Joseph Moakley, according to Carucci.

"He was a great guy who was at

the top of his field," said Ernie Boch, who was friends with Mr. Santini for 15 years. Mr. Santini was an usher at Boch's wedding. "He was a loyal friend."

Carruci said, "The man was passionate about his work... He was one of the best at what he did."

Mr. Santini is survived by his mother, Mary (Buter) of Holbrook; five sisters, Audrey of Florida, Joan Vierbickas of Braintree, Claire Chiampa of Milton, Mary Santini-Shea of Norwood and Christina Stewart of California; and a brother, Paul of Weymouth.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. tomorrow at St. Bridgid Church, South Boston.
