- WHEREAS: A great deal of time and city resources have been expended to date in trying to resolve so-called "conflicts of law" issues for properties under rent control; and
- WHEREAS: it is important that city departments and agencies report fully and accurately on relevant laws and regulations to this City Council; and
- WHEREAS: Copies of Section 7 of Chapter 40A, Section 119 of the State Building Code, and the 1990 Single Room Occupancy Conversion Moratorium Law have been provided to the Inspectional Service Department ("ISD"), the Rent Control Board, and the City Solicitor's office; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct ISD, the Rent Control Board and the City Solicitor's Office to apply these laws and regulations and to all other cases; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to this City Council by May 7, 1990 on the results of these requested investigations by said departments and agencies of the City of Cambridge.
