WHEREAS:-

On Tuesday, June 1, 1971 an order was adopted by the School Committee to provide for a course in Irish history and culture at Cambridge Latin and Rindge Technical Schools in the coming fall semester, and

WHEREAS:-

A study of Irish history is particularly relevant in the City of Cambridge since the Irish immigrants and their descendants are the largest majority in the University City, and the struggle for Irish independence led to the formation of the Irish Free State in October 1921 and became a model for other nations, who a generation later would seek to free themselves from colonial status, therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Council go on record endorsing the action taken by the School Committee in providing for a course in Irish history, and be it further

ORDERED:-

That the School Committee be and hereby is requested to arrange tours of Ireland for student groups under appropriate supervision in the near future.
