On Saturday, October 6, the new Waltham High School track at Leary Field (Bacon St., Waltham) will be named and dedicated to former long time Waltham coach, Lee Gould. The dedication will be held at 1:00 p.m., just prior to the Homecoming Football game. A pre-dedication social will be held from 12:00-1:00 p.m. at the east end of the track.

Waltham will also inaugurate its first ever All Sport Hall of Fame. Coach Gould is one of the seven inductees. The hall of fame ceremony will take place during half time of the football game.

A special reception for Coach Gould will be held at 4:30 p.m. in the foyer of the Waltham High School Auditorium (left end of the school building, 670 Lexington St.) A cold buffet will be available for those who attend.

We are flying Coach and his wife up from Florida earlier in the week. We plan to present him a plaque, special portfolio of pictures, dedication support letters and notes of thanks, as well as the dedication sign which will be attached to the fence surrounding the track. Below is my draft for the dedication informational sign to be displayed at each main entrance. J. Lee Gould

Dedicated on October 6, 2001

Coach J. Lee Gould was the cross-country and the track and field coach at Waltham High School from 1959-1981, compiling a record of 385-187. Known for his derby hat and unlit cigar, he was a dedicated coach who was extremely generous with his time and who cared deeply for each of his athletes. He had the unique ability to make each member of his team feel important and special, regardless of his ability. He was whatever "his boys" needed him to be - a coach, friend, father or mentor.

As a coach and role model, Coach Gould insisted on a high standard of conduct, appearance and values, as he instilled in his athletes a sense of pride, respect, model citizenship and a desire to excel; qualities that served them throughout their lives. He was instrumental in helping his athletes with their college pursuits, often driving them to visit schools throughout New England and the Eastern U. S. His athletes went on to compete at more than sixty colleges from Boston to Texas, from S. Dakota to Florida. His task was not just to coach his athletes, but to make sure their lives after Waltham High were meaningful and successful.
