WHEREAS: Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services, Inc. has primarily, through the use of local and private resources and countless hours of volunteer work, rehabbed and thus preserved over 800 apartments as affordable housing throughout Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: Cambridge Neighborhood Apartment Housing Services, Inc. is an outstanding member organization of Neighborhood Reinvestment Corporation, which provides the energy and vision to repair, restore and create nearly 16,000 affordable housing units each year, generating more than \$300 million of community revitalization investment; and

WHEREAS: National NeighborWorks® Week was initiated in 1984 by a United States Congressional resolution and launched in the spring of 1986 as an annual celebration of neighborhood pride and unity among approximately 600 communities across the country; now therefore be it

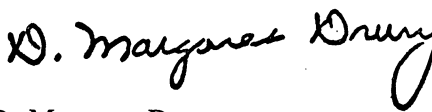

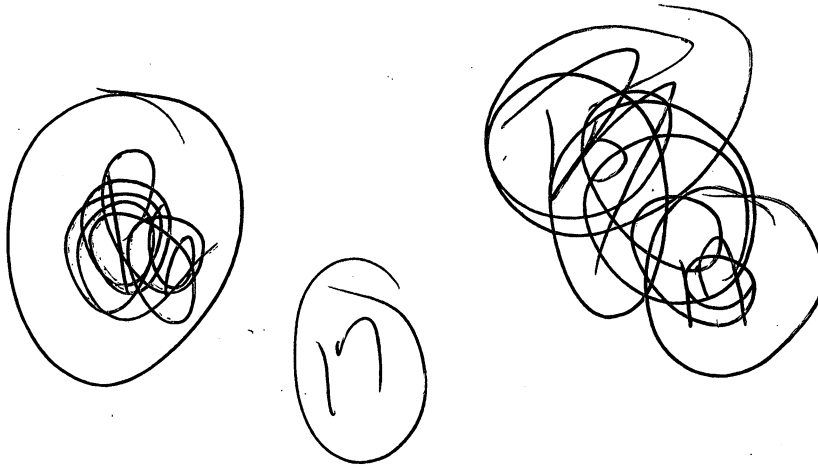
