VI. CONCLUSION

Cambridge has addressed the housing challenges of the past twenty years with a spirit of innovation and determination, but also one of reflection and flexibility. One of the results of this unique Cambridge spirit has been and continues to be rent control. The coming decades present new challenges as well as old dilemmas. The determination of the City of Cambridge to provide affordable housing and to insure the continued diversity of its population remains strong. While everyone cannot agree on the specifics of policy, my experience has indicated that virtually all of the people of Cambridge share the underlying values of compassion and respect for diversity which are the driving force behind the City's adoption of rent control.

It is also an almost universal belief that the challenges of the future will require continued innovation in rent control and overall housing policy. It is my hope that this report will provide an outline of ideas and fresh perspectives with which to address continuing and familiar problems and to meet the challenges of the future.
