- WHEREAS: This City Council is in receipt of a petition from Eleanor Powers, in behalf of the Cambridge Farmer's Market and the Gardener's Market, requesting permission to use the City-owned parking lot without charge located on Bishop Allen Drive and Norfolk Street, on each Monday from the first Monday in June (June 6, 1983), to October 31, 1983 during the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the departments concerned to grant the required permits and licenses pursuant to the request of the petitioner; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Traffic and Parking to waive all parking fees for the meters within the parking lot located on Bishop Allen Drive and Norfolk Street and the surrounding areas for the purpose of allowing consumers to participate in the Farmer's Market during the period when the market is being conducted and to take whatever steps are necessary, including the posting of signs, to ensure that the intent of this order is being carried out.
