Whereas the lighting equipment on Massachusetts Avenue from Quincy Square to Church Street, on Brattle Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Church Street and on Boylston Street from Massachusetts Avenue to Mount Auburn Street is obsolete, defective and inefficient, and

Whereas the contract between the City and the Cambridge Electric Light Company provides for lights of 1,000 candle power each at a substantial cost, and

Whereas the present system does not furnish light as required by said contract;

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Cambridge Electric Light Company is hereby directed to replace the obsolete lights in said district with modern and efficient equipment.
