

To the Honorable, the City Council:

On September 15, 1975, the City Council appropriated a \$500,000 grant from the Economic Development Administration of the United States Department of Commerce. At that time, I indicated that the City match of \$125,000 was already appropriated as part of the Community Development Block Grant. Since then, arrangements have been completed for the allocation of the City match which require the funds to be in the Other Ordinary Maintenance category.
