The Honorable, the City Council:

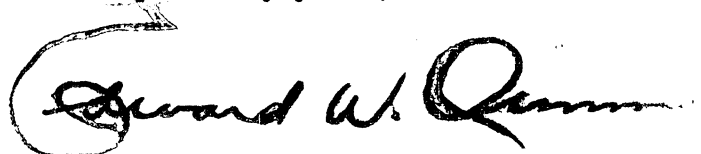
I regret to announce to you the death of William Shannon which occurred at his home on Monday, January 28. Mr. Shannon was one of the two surviving members of the first company of volunteers to enlist in the Civil War, April 17, 1861, the sixty-eighth anniversary of which takes place April 17th next.

The late Captain John Kinnear, whose death occurred October 11, 1928, was also a member of this company. This leaves but one survivor of this gallant band of volunteers.

At the annual gatherings of the First Volunteers Citizens' Association Mr. Shannon was always an active and inspiring participant. His genial presence, as well as that of Capt. Kinnear, will be greatly missed at the annual celebration in April.

I respectfully recommend that suitable action be taken by your Honorable Board as a mark of respect to the memory of Mr. Shannon, in which action I am ready to join.
