In Common Council, April 20. 1887.

Ordered,

That the Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to advertise for proposals and contracts for ^{having} teaming gravel from the city gravel pits near Fresh Pond, as follows:

300 yards more or less to Howard street between Dunster and Bow streets,

1500 yards more or less to main street, between Portland street and the crossing opposite no. 500 on said main street,

In case any parties desire to furnish satisfactory having gravel and deliver the same as hereinbefore stated, at the cost of teaming said gravel, only, the committee to be authorized to contract for the required quantities.

The expense of the foregoing to be charged to the proper appropriations.
