To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$644,400.00 in U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development HOME Program funds to the Community Development Extraordinary Expenditure Account to provide funds for the HOME Program, which was established through the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990. The goal of this program is to assist states and municipalities in expanding their supplies of safe, decent and affordable housing. The Community Development Department will base the selection of projects to be funded through this appropriation on the City's Comprehensive Housing Affordability Strategy, which is approved annually by HUD. The housing units to be developed include acquisition/moderate rehabilitation, substantial rehabilitation or new construction for low-income families and individuals who require social service support. Emphasis will be placed on rental units, although first time homebuyer units will also be developed.
