

Know all men by these Presents,
That we, the undersigned, owners of
lands abutting on Sparks Street, so called,
between Brooker Street and Mount Auburn
Street, in the City of Cambridge, in con-
sideration of One Dollar to us paid,
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and for other good and valua-
ble considerations, for ourselves, our heirs,
Executors and Administrators, hereby
respectively covenant, promise and agree
to and with the City of Cambridge, that
if the City Council of said City shall lay
out and accept said Sparks Street as
a public street or way, according to a
Plan now in the possession of the City
Engineer, neither we, nor any person
claiming by, through or under us, shall
claim any damages for the land over
which said street shall be laid out,
nor for any changes in the grade of
said street which, in the judgment of
the Surveyors of Highways, it may be
necessary to make, and which, in fur-
surance of any order of said Surveyors,
may be made, and that we will hold
the said City harmless and indemnified
from and against any such claim.
