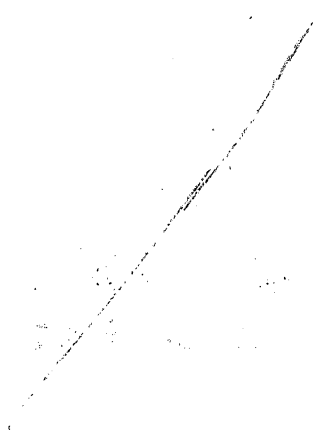

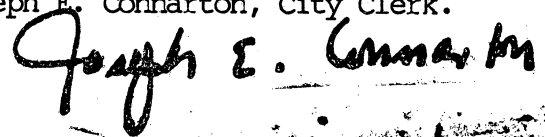
COUNCILLOR WALTER SULLIVAN
