WHEREAS:

Daniel Cronin, a member of the Water Board, passed away on March 18, 1935 and his death has caused sorrow to many of his associates and friends, it is deemed fitting and proper that some notice of this sad event should be recorded.

Mr. Cronin's first entry into the public life of the City occurred when he was elected to serve as a member of the Common Council of 1904 - 1905. He served as a member of the Sinking Fund Commission during the years 1931 - 1934 and as a member of the Water Board from August 21, 1934 until his death. During his long life in Cambridge he was held in high esteem by those whose regard was of value. He proved his worth during his incumbency on the various Boards, was easy of approach, friendly, genial, upright and always dependable when good judgment was needed in the administration of the affairs of the Sinking Fund Commission and Water Board. It is therefore

RESOLVED:-

That the City Council hereby acknowledges the loss sustained by the City and his legion of friends in the passing away of Daniel Cronin and directs that a copy of these resolutions be spread upon the records.
