- WHEREAS: Numerous citizen complaints have been received regarding heavy truck traffic on Middlesex Street during night time hours and on Sundays; and
- WHEREAS: These people are being deprived not only of their night's sleep, but also the right to have peace and quiet on Sundays; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager direct the Director of Traffic and Parking to prohibit heavy trucking on Middlesex Street between the hours of 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM daily and from 4:00 PM Saturday to 7:00 AM Monday and also to investigate the possibility of using the MBTA right-of-way along the tracks as a possible alternative route for this heavy truck traffic.
