XX met on February 15th, to discuss the complaints and issues raised by residents of the Cambridgeport Area resulting from the Pearl-Valentine Streets fire and reports as follows:

1. That City Manager John H. Corcoran was instructed to request the appearance of the Building Commissioner, the Fire Chief and all members of their respective staffs who have knowledge of any inspections made of the premises occupied by AAA Plastics prior to the fire and subsequent thereto.
2. That the Fire Marshal of the Commonwealth, or his designated representative be required to attend the next meeting of the sub-committee and provide any information or reports relative to his investigation.
3. That the City Manager has been directed to send inspectors from the Building, Fire and Health Departments to the Jeremiah Sullivan Garage to determine whether ~~XXXXXX~~ there is any violation of law in the conduct of this business with particular reference to the storage of gasoline.
4. That the City Manager was directed to assign an Asst. City Solicitor to the sub-committee and to take the necessary action to establish the boundary lines of the abutting properties on Valentine Street.
5. That the City Manager request the presence of the owners of AAA Plastics at the next meeting of the committee.
