TO THE HONORABLE, THE CAMBRIDGE CITY COUNCIL

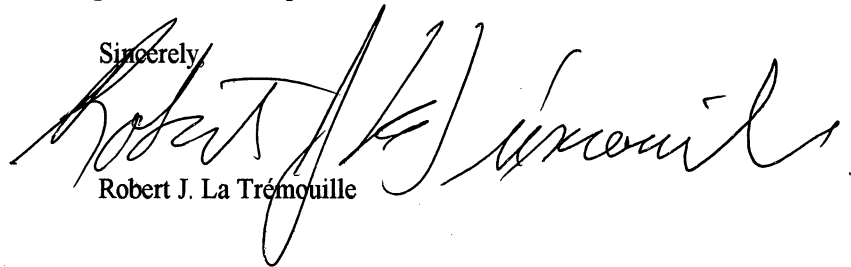
The apparently final vote taken this evening on Quincy Square demonstrates the gross lack of responsibility of the new city council rules.
