- WHEREAS: On Wednesday, September 16, 1998 Marsha A. Cannon will be sworn in as the new Postmaster of Cambridge at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology; and
- WHEREAS: Ms. Cannon was born in Cambridge and was raised in Mattapan and Dorchester, graduating from Saint Gregory High School in 1965 and attending Boston State College; and
- WHEREAS: This event marks only the second installation of a Postmaster in Cambridge since 1873, the Cambridge Post Offices being branches of the Boston Post Office from then until 1990 when they were reestablished as an independent office under Frank Carbonneau, the first Postmaster in the twentieth century; and
- WHEREAS: Cambridge is one of the nation's oldest Post Offices, encompassing 7 stations, with 360 employees who each day help to deliver the mail to 46,000 delivery points and serve their postal needs; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council extend its congratulations to Marsha Cannon on her appointment as Postmaster of Cambridge and wish her all the best in her new position; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and is hereby requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Marsha Cannon.

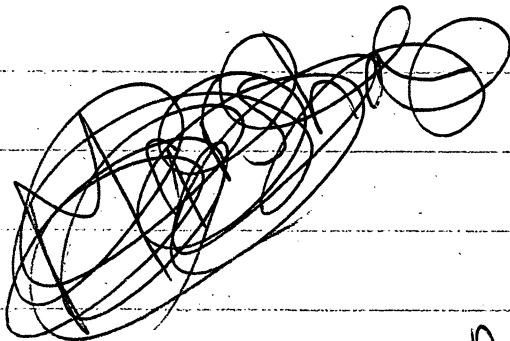
