- WHEREAS: This City Council was saddened upon learning of the death of Costas "Charlie" Maliotis, a philanthropist, industrialist and leader among the Greek Orthodox community; and
- WHEREAS: "Charlie", as he was known to his many friends and admirers was born in Crete in 1895 and came to America in 1915, serving this country during World War I as a member of the United States Army; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Maliotis organized the Mediterranean Trading Corporation in 1945 and in subsequent years founded Lehigh Metal Products Corporation and Eastern Fasteners and Freetown Screw Companies in New Bedford; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Maliotis was truly busy with his professional life, he none the less found time to serve on many boards and commissions, such as the Cultural Society of Boston, where he served as President of that organization in 1922, as well as having served as a past President of the Demosthenes Club, as well as being a member of the American Legion and the Mixed Council of the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese of North and South America, who honored him on many occasions for his contributions to the betterment of his native country and his faith; and
- WHEREAS: In addition to being given the title of "Archon" by His Eminence Archbishop Iakovos, he was the recipient on two occasions, of the Gold Cross of the Royal Order of the Phoenix, which was awarded by the Government of Greece; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mary Maliotis on this very sad occasion; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Maliotis on behalf of the entire City Council.
