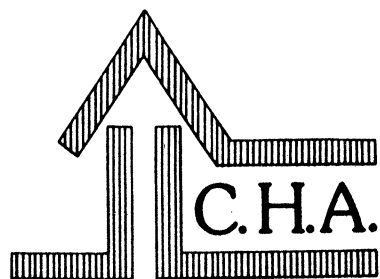

Since my last report the posting period for additional CETA applicants was closed. Lists were received from the CETA office and ten applicants were interviewed on June 6 by representatives of the Tenant Services Department, selected Elderly Development Managers, and a number of Elderly Development Tenant Council Presidents. Selections based on appropriate background checks for these security-sensitive positions will be made hopefully within the next ten days at which time final CETA hiring will be sought.

Assuming no unexpected delays, we can expect full security coverage at the major elderly developments within the next three weeks.

Currently the Millers River Apartments has three-quarters coverage, Manning Apartments has three quarters coverage, with spot coverage being provided to the Harry S. Truman and LBJ Apartments.
