- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of former City Manager John J. Curry, a life long Cantabridgian, and
- WHEREAS: John J. Curry was a graduate of Rindge Technical School and a cum laude graduate of Harvard College class of 1919, as well as, receiving a master's degree in education from Harvard in 1930 and a PHD from Boston College in 1938, and
- WHEREAS: John J. Curry began his public school teaching career in 1924 and in 1930 was appointed Junior Master of Cambridge High and Latin School and only one year later was appointed Master of the Fletcher School, remaining in that position until 1936 at which time he was appointed Master of the Roberts School, a position he held until his appointment as City Manager in 1952, and
- WHEREAS: John J. Curry served the City of Cambridge with distinction for 14 years as its Chief Executive Officer, a title he held so dear and took so seriously, and
- WHEREAS: John J. Curry, throughout his tenure as "Mr. Manager", never lost his ideals or changed his philosophy as a humanitarian, teacher and public servant; a person who not only enjoyed the results of his work, but the work itself, now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to Ellen C. Ryan, sister of the late Mr. Curry, and her entire family at this time of such personal loss, and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitable engrossed copy of this resolution to ~~Ms~~ Ellen Ryan on behalf of the entire City Council.
