- WHEREAS: This plan is the culmination of ten months work by a combined group of hospital administrators, medical staff and representatives of the Health Policy Board; and
- WHEREAS: The Committee on Health and Hospitals believes that the Strategic Plan and the process from which it came is a critical vehicle within which to assess the strengths and weaknesses of the Cambridge Hospital in order to allow it to continue to be a major provider of health care services to the entire community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record endorsing the Strategic Business Plan Development for the Cambridge Hospital and further congratulate the hospital administrator, staff and Health Policy Board members responsible for the development of this plan.
