Subject City Council Order #35, dated 11/18/91 Re: "Parking For Volunteers of City Departments"

The Traffic Department has investigated the feasibility of allowing free parking at meters for volunteers of various city agencies. It is our opinion that this would require a Special Act of the Legislature as parking meters are installed in accordance with state laws that are intended to ration parking so that every person has a chance to park.

Secondly, this would create a serious problem with other public agencies in the city who would want the same privileges and finally the administering of such a program would create serious control problems.

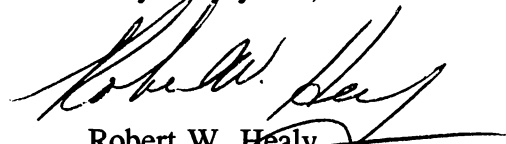
