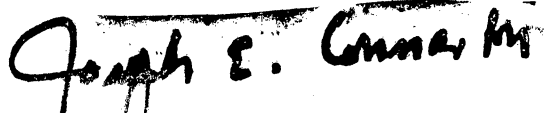

- WHEREAS: The Cambridge City Council, on March 7, 1988, adopted a resolution to support legislation, the Massachusetts Economic Diversification Act, to facilitate business efforts to develop non-weapons applications, thereby reducing dependency on military contracting and preserving jobs for citizens; and
- WHEREAS: This legislation has been refiled as H3693 and S96, sponsored by, among others Senator LoPresti, Barrett and Kraus, and Representatives Flaherty and Thompson of the Cambridge delegation in the Great and General Court; and
- WHEREAS: This legislation might have benefits for the Cambridge community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council reaffirm its support of the Massachusetts Economic Diversification Act, H3693 and S96; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be requested to send an engrossed copy of this resolution to the Committee on Commerce and Labor, chaired by Senator Lois Pines and Representative Marilyn Travinski, which will hear this bill on March 29, 1989.
