The Joint-Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges to which were referred the Petitions of S B Withey and Evan Brown for increased compensation and for an extension of time granted for the removal of their houses,

Would respectfully Report; That they have employed two competent experts to make a careful and extended examination of the petitioners' premises and the result of the same has been as follows;

To move back the house of S B Withey and make all repairs the estimate being given in detail \$1204.57

For depreciation of Estate by standing too near the Street 700.00

For depreciation, having less land in rear 200.00

" Rent- and disturbance 300.00

Total award exclusive of land damages \$2404.57

The same to be in full for all damages to his estate on Brattle Street. The same to be charged to the Appropriation for Streets & Paving.

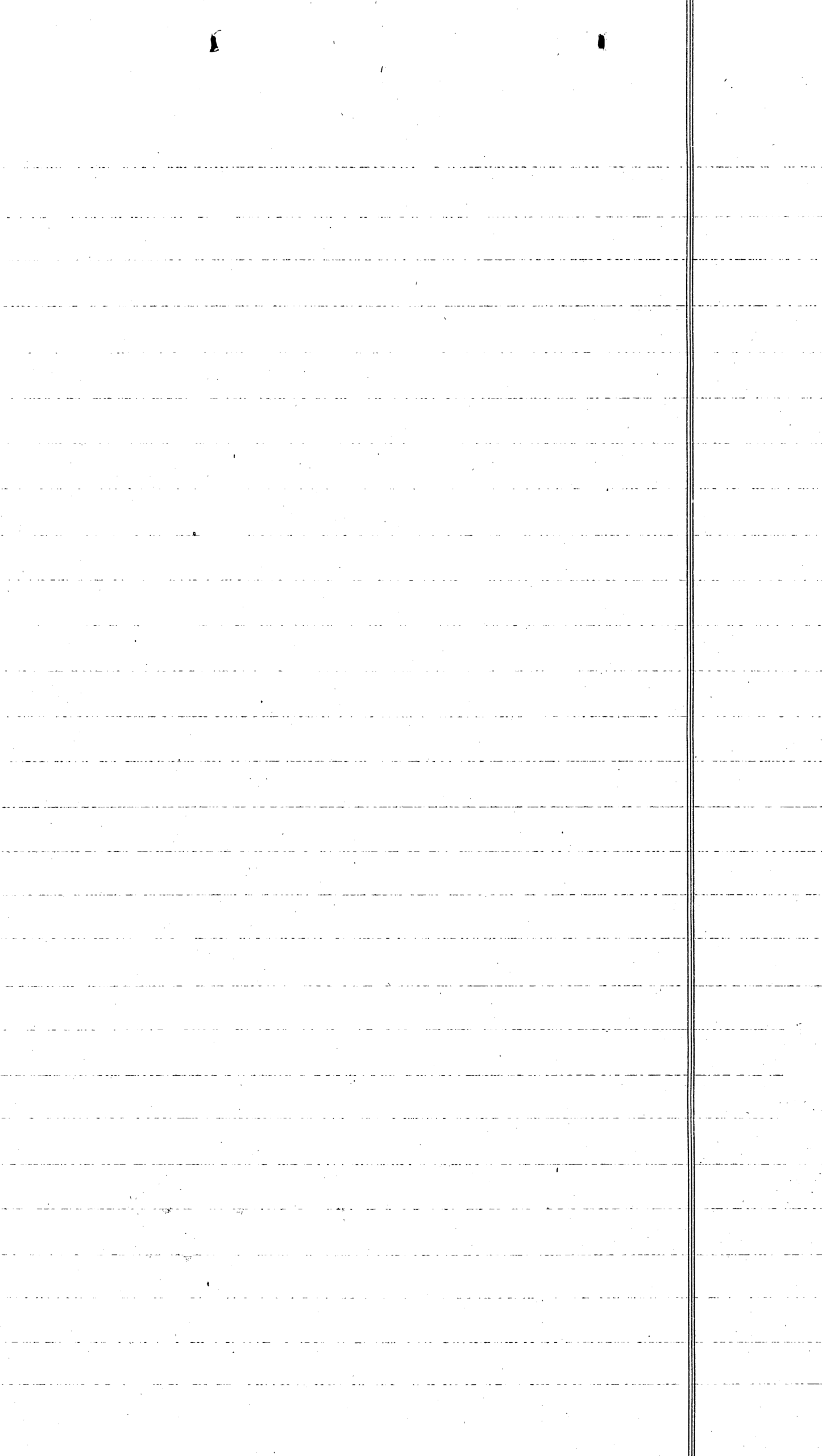
