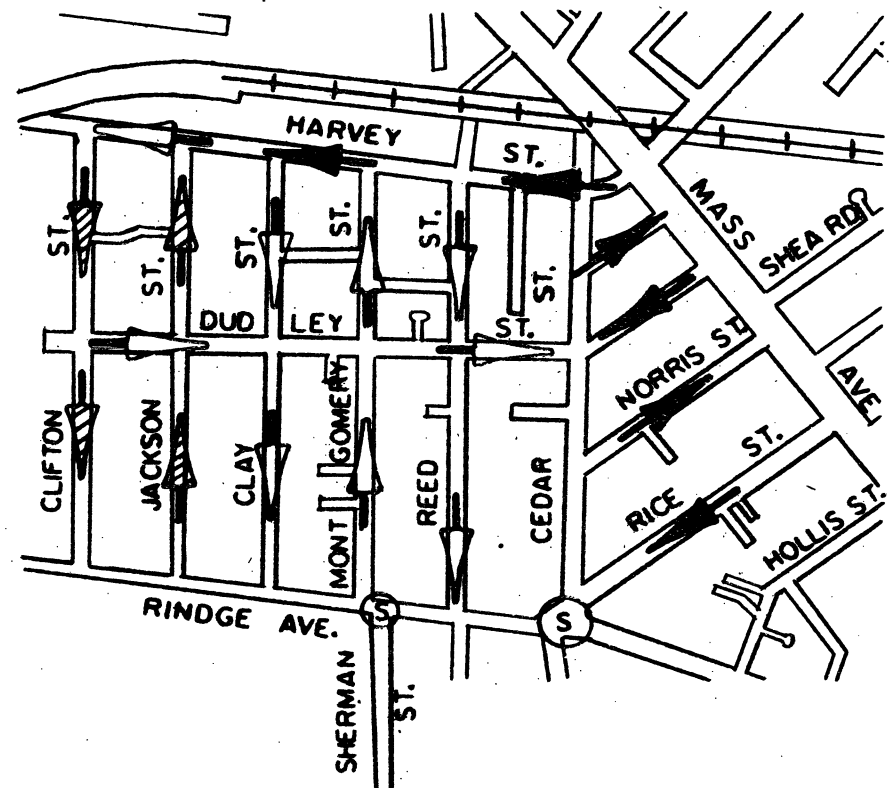
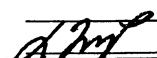

Dear Resident:

We have been asked by the City Manager and the Mayor to conduct a study of your area, and correct the traffic situation which now exists.

Our preliminary survey shows most public ways are 26' wide, except Harvey Street and Westley Avenue which are 20' wide. All other streets in this area are less than 20'. Since a parked car needs eight feet from the curb, cars parked along both sides of a 26' wide street would leave a ten foot travel lane down the middle. This is the minimum width required by Fire Department vehicles.

In order to leave the maximum amount of curb parking in your area, we propose the following measures be taken:

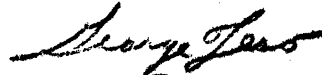
1. A one way street pattern be established, as shown on the enclosed plan.
2. Parking be restricted ONLY where less than a ten foot lane is left, when cars park along the curb.

The other alternative would be to restrict parking to only one side at all times on streets 26' wide and to allow "No Parking" at all on those streets less than 26' wide.

Since this area is mostly residential, we would appreciate your opinion about these two proposals. Enclosed is a postcard on which to indicate your preference. Please add any remarks you feel might help us in correcting the traffic flow in this area. Please return postcards to this Department before March 1, 1971.
