Inbound on the southerly side from apoint

Outbound on the northerly side from 567 Mass-
achusetts Avenue to Essex Street.

the curbings at these locations.

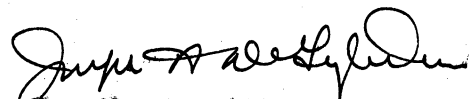
