- WHEREAS: Arthur, who was first appointed in 1969 as a Member of the Planning Board, had long been active in civic affairs, serving as a Member of the Riverside Neighborhood Association and was active in various activities organized by the Cambridge Community Center, where he served as a Tutor; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur served as Chairman of the Planning Board for many years, and during a time when several critical and sensitive issues were before the Board; such as the Alewife Project, the Harvard Square Overlay, Kendall Square and the Lechmere Canal Project; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur, a Cambridge native who is employed as an Engineer by Raytheon Company, served the people of Cambridge with distinction, always demonstrating dignity and a high degree of professionalism as he remained objective and impartial while conducting the meetings of the Planning Board; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep appreciation and gratitude to Arthur Parris for his long and dedicated service to the people of Cambridge for many years; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Arthur on behalf of the entire City Council.
