- WHEREAS: The problem of litter continues to be a major problem in all neighborhoods and squares of the city; and
- WHEREAS: Trash from fast-food and convenience establishments substantially add to this problem; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager is hereby requested to have the City Solicitor draft an amendment to Ordinance 798, the anti-litter Ordinance, section 5.03 that requires fast food establishments and convenience stores to provide litter receptacles outside the entrance of their establishments, and to keep them emptied; and be it further
- ORDERED: That these stores be required to post "**Please do not Litter**" signs in the establishments.
