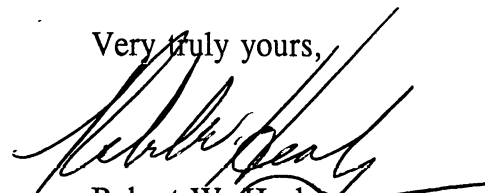
To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached please find for your review and action a transfer from the School Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$100,000.00 to the School Department Salary & Wages Account \$90,000.00 and Travel & Training Account \$10,000.00. This transfer, approved by the School Committee on December 21, 1993, reflects revisions made within the approved FY94 School Budget. The transfer in salaries will support three instructional aides for the Amigos Program; elementary librarian staffing; a principal and parent liaison for the Cambridgeport Program; the Bilingual Haitian Summer School Program; staffing for the elementary science resource center; and maintenance of parent liaison support in schools due to level funding of Chapter 636 grant.

The training funds will be used for administration training for the new teacher evaluation system under the Education Reform Act.

Passage of this order is recommended.
