- WHEREAS:** It has come to the attention of this City Council that Eric Cutler, long-time Harvard University administrator will retire from the University, effective June 30, 1983 from his position as Assistant Director of Inter-collegiate Athletics; and
- WHEREAS:** He has been an outstanding administrator and coach for over thirty years since his graduation from Harvard College in 1940 where he received his AB Degree; and
- WHEREAS:** He was one of the top ten freshman swimmers in the country, but was unable to compete during his sophomore year due to polio, however, through his perseverance, dedication and hard work he was to be selected as All-American Swimmer during his junior and senior years of college; and
- WHEREAS:** He served as a United States Army pilot during World War II and later worked in the business world for six years prior to his employment at Harvard University in 1951; and
- WHEREAS:** He interviewed hundreds of student applicants from throughout the country and advised them during their stay at Harvard and upon being recognized for his dedication and efforts to the students, was appointed Assistant Director of Intercollegiate Athletics in 1965 where he has contributed to the development of programs geared to the needs and desires of undergraduate and graduate students, as well as to the Harvard Community; and
- WHEREAS:** He has been a distinguished leader in the Greater Boston Athletic Conference, the New England Athletic Conference, the Eastern College Athletic Conference, the National Collegiate Athletic Association, a college coach at Harvard and an active member of the Harvard Community who made many contributions in a wide variety of activities, including the FLY Club; and
- WHEREAS:** His wisdom and knowledge have been a great benefit to Harvard University and to the Cambridge Community; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED:** That the City of Cambridge recognize the outstanding career of Eric Cutler; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That a copy of this citation be made a permanent record of the City Council through its incorporation into the Council record; and be it further
- RESOLVED:** That a copy of this resolution be presented to Eric Cutler on November 19, 1982 with appreciation for his leadership and friendship and with best wishes for good birding and happy days.
